KATIE BRUNO • Ramapo College
Sophomore • Forward • Middletown, NJ/Middletown South

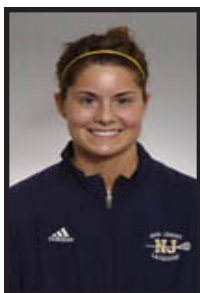
Bruno earns the first NJAC Offensive Player of the Week selection after tallying nine points in a 1-1 opening week of play for Ramapo. She opened her sophomore season by netting the game-winning goal while adding an assist for three points in the Roadrunners' season-opening 7-0 road win at Neumann. She wrapped up her first week with a hat-trick in Ramapo's 5-4 overtime road loss at Elizabethtown. Bruno currently leads the NJAC in points (9), and is tied for the conference lead in goals (4).



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LAUREN DOBBS • Kean University
Senior • Goaltender • Palmyra, NJ/Palmyra

Dobbs earns the first NJAC Defensive Player of the Week selection after collecting 11 total saves in a 2-1 opening week of play for the Cougars. She kicked off her senior season by notching nine saves in a 2-1 overtime loss to Wesley. She later capped off the week by posting back-to-back road shutouts in Kean's respective 2-0 and 3-0 wins over Misericordia and Muhlenberg. Dobbs currently leads the NJAC in both goals against average (0.64) and shutouts (2).



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Sophomore • Forward • Pennsauken, NJ/Camden Catholic

A veteran lacrosse player but a first-time collegiate competitor in the sport of field hockey, Notos earns the first NJAC Rookie of the Week selection after notching four points in a 3-0 opening week of play for TCNJ. After not scoring in her first collegiate game, she scored a goal and added an assist in her second contest, a 3-1 road win over King's. One day later, she wrapped up the week by assisting on the game-winning goal in the Lions' 2-1 road win at No. 16 Juniata. Notos currently is tied for the conference lead in assists (2).
