OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KEITH CORCORAN • Rowan University
Sophomore • Running Back • Atlantic City, NJ/St. Joseph's

Corcoran earns the first NJAC Offensive Player of the Week selection after helping to propel the Profs to a season-opening 24-17 victory over Lycoming. In the first start of his collegiate career, he averaged 7.3 yards per attempt with 21 carries for a career-high 153 yards on the ground. His touchdown run was a 73-yard effort midway through the third quarter which extended Rowan's lead to 24-0. Corcoran currently leads the NJAC in rushing with an average of 153 yards per game.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JIM HAMILL • William Paterson University
Senior • Linebacker • Stanhope, NJ/Lenape Valley Region

Hamill earns the first NJAC Defensive Player of the Week selection after helping the Pioneers post a season-opening 15-7 NJAC road win at TCNJ. In the victory, he notched 11 tackles, including three solo stops in a defensive effort which held the Lions to just 135 yards of total offense. Hamill, who helped Paterson secure its first win in Ewing since 1992, currently ranks tied for fourth in the NJAC in tackles per game (11.0).



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ANTONIO REGALBUTO • Rowan University
Sophomore • Kicker • Clayton, NJ/St. Joseph's

Regalbuto earns the first NJAC Special Teams Player of the Week selection after contributing to the Profs' season-opening 24-17 victory over Lycoming. In his first contest at Rowan, he connected on a 35-yard field goal in his only attempt of the day. He also was a perfect 3-for-3 on extra point attempts, finishing the game with six points scored. Regalbuto currently leads the NJAC in both extra points made (3) and extra point percentage (100.0).



OFFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

JAKE SPALIK • The College at Brockport
Freshman • Wide Receiver • Johnson City, NY/Johnson City

Spalik earns the first NJAC Offensive Rookie of the Week selection after collecting a team-high 10 receptions in Brockport's season-opening 55-12 road defeat at St. John Fisher. In the first game of his collegiate career, he notched 10 receptions for 56 yards while also garnering 11 yards rushing on two attempts. Spalik currently ranks second in the NJAC in receptions per game (10.0).



DEFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

JEREMY STEWART • Morrisville State College
Freshman • Defensive Back • Moravia, NY/Moravia

Stewart earns the first NJAC Defensive Rookie of the Week selection after contributing in the Mustangs' season-opening 31-20 defeat to Hartwick. In the first game of his collegiate career, he started at right cornerback and notched five tackles, including two solo stops and a pass break-up. Stewart currently ranks tied for second in the NJAC in passes defended per game (1.00).
