#### **TRACK ATHLETE OF THE WEEK**

**STEVE MURRAY** • The College of New Jersey  
Senior • East Windsor, NJ/Hightstown

Murray earns NJAC Men's Outdoor Track Athlete of the Week honors after traveling to Bethlehem, PA to compete at the Greyhound Invitational hosted by Moravian. He placed third in a field of 36 competitors and was the top Division III finisher in the 400 meters with an ECAC qualifying time of 49.14. He also competed as a member of the Lions' 4x400 meter relay which placed first in a field of 16 teams with an ECAC qualifying time of 3:17.92. Murray also placed 14th in a field of 41 competitors in the 200 meters with a time of 22.86.

Van Leeuwen earns his second NJAC Outdoor Track & Field weekly honor of the season after traveling to Bethlehem, PA to compete at Moravian's Greyhound Invitational. He placed first in a field of 27 competitors in the pole vault with an ECAC qualifying mark of 4.57 meters. Van Leeuwen claimed the victory in the event which included competitors from Division I institutions Lehigh, Temple, Lafayette, and Monmouth.

Lisa earns NJAC Men's Outdoor Track & Field Rookie of the Week honors for the second time this season after traveling to Pomona to compete at the CTC Championships contested at Stockton's G. Larry James Stadium. He placed first in a field of 20 competitors in the long jump with a NCAA provisional leap of 7.03 meters. Lisa's performance helped propel the Profs to a second place overall finish in the 16-team CTC Championship.
