PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CHRISTINE VELOTT • Richard Stockton College
Sophomore • Outside Hitter • Moorestown, NJ/Moorestown

Velott earns NJAC Player of the Week honors for the third time this season and the second consecutive week after averaging 4.25 kills and 2.67 digs per game in a 2-1 week of play for Stockton. She opened the week with 14 kills and four digs in the Ospreys' 3-1 NJAC road defeat at Montclair State. Three days later, she wrapped up her regular season by recording a double-double 14 kills and 13 digs in a 3-1 win over Neumann, and a double-double 23 kills and 15 digs in a 3-1 victory over DeSales. The second-seeded Ospreys will open play in the 2009 NJAC Championship Tournament by hosting the winner of the opening round Ramapo-Rutgers-Camden match in the semifinals. Velott currently ranks second in the NJAC in kills with an average of 3.49 per game.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

KATIE HAVLICEK • Rowan University
Freshman • Outside Hitter • Midland Park, NJ/Immaculate Heart

Havlicek earns NJAC Rookie of the Week honors for the eighth time this season and the fourth consecutive week after averaging 4.57 kills and 2.29 digs per game in a 2-0 week of play for Rowan. She opened the week by producing a double-double 24 kills and 11 digs in the Profs' 3-1 NJAC road victory at Kean. Two days later, she wrapped up her regular season by tallying eight kills and five digs in a 3-0 non-conference road victory at Penn State-Abington. The fifth-seeded Profs will open play in the 2009 NJAC Championship Tournament by traveling to face William Paterson in the opening round. Havlicek currently ranks fourth in the NJAC in kills with an average of 3.21 per game.
